EXPRESSIONS:

INTRODUCING SOMEONE

1. This is Connor.
2. I'd like you to meet Adam.
3. Have you met Mr. Moore?
4. Let me introduce you to Alice.
5. I don't think you two have met.
6. Let me introduce you guys.

EXAMPLES:

1.
 - This is Connor. He's new to the team.
 - Hi, Connor! Happy to have you here.
2.
 - I'd like you to meet Adam. He's visiting from New York.
 - Hi, Adam! Welcome!
3.
 - Have you met Mr. Moore?
 - Yes, I met him yesterday.
4.
 - Let me introduce you to Alice. She's from Canada.
 - Hello, Alice! I'm from Mexico.
5.
 - I don't think you two have met. This is Alex.
 - Hi, Alex! Where are you from?
6.
 - Let me introduce you guys. You'll be classmates.
 - Hello, everyone!

CONVERSATION:

- A. This is Sarah.
- B. Nice to meet you, Sarah.
- C. Nice to meet you, too.
- A. Sarah just moved here last week.
- B. Oh, really? Welcome!
- C. Thank you!
- B. What do you think of the party?
- C. It's great! I'm having a lot of fun.

RESPONDING TO INTRODUCTIONS

1. Nice to meet you.
2. Pleased to meet you.
3. It's a pleasure to meet you.
4. I've heard a lot about you.
5. It's great to finally meet you.
6. Good to meet you in person.

 - I'm Mark. I'm in your class.
 - Nice to meet you, Mark!
8.
 - Hello! My name is Jason.
 - Pleased to meet you, Jason.
9.
 - I'm Anna. I work in marketing.
 - It's a pleasure to meet you, Anna.
10.
 - Hello! I'm Laura, your new neighbor.
 - I've heard a lot about you, Laura. Nice to meet you.
11.
 - Hi, I'm Emily. We talked on the phone last week.
 - It's great to finally meet you, Emily.
12.
 - Hi, I'm Grace. We chatted last month.
 - Good to meet you in person, Grace.

1. Hello there! It's great to see you!
2. Hi! How's your day?
3. Good morning.
4. Good afternoon.
5. Good evening.
6. Hey! How's it going?
7. What's up?
8. How are you?
9. How's everything?
10. Nice to see you.
11. Long time no see!
12. How have you been?

EXAMPLES:

1.
 - Hello there! It's great to see you!
You look well.
 - Thank you! So do you.
2.
 - Hi! How's your day?
 - It's been busy! What about yours?
3.
 - Good morning!
 - Morning! Ready for today?
4.
 - Good afternoon!
 - Good afternoon! How's your day going?
5.
 - Good evening!
 - Good evening! How was work today?
6.
 - Hey! How's it going?
 - Pretty good! Just finished my lunch.
7.
 - What's up?
 - Not much! Just got back from the gym.
8.
 - How are you?
 - I'm okay! I had a relaxing weekend.

 - How's everything?
 - Not bad! I just got back from a short trip.

 - Same! How's your family?

 - Call me if you need anything.

 - Bye! Drive safely.

 - I'll call you when I'm close.

 - You too! Enjoy your afternoon.

6. Could you hold the line, please?
7. I'm sorry, Jane is not available right now.
8. Can I take a message?
9. Could you repeat that, please?
10. I'll call you back later.
11. Thank you for calling.
12. Can I take your number?

EXAMPLES:

 - Hello, this is Anna speaking.
 - Hi, Anna. I'd like to schedule an appointment, please.

 - Hello, I'm having trouble with my internet connection.
 - I see. Who's calling, please?

 - Thank you for calling National Bank. How may I assist you?
 - May I speak with Mr. Jones, please?
4.
 - May I speak with Ms. Roberts?
 - Just a moment, please. I'll see if she's in her office.

 - Can I talk to Mr. Johnson about the job application?
 - Just a second. I'll put you through.
6.
 - I'm calling to confirm my flight details.
 - Could you hold the line, please?

 - Hello, is Jane there?
 - I'm sorry, Jane is not available right now. She's running errands.

 - No, not right now. Can I take a message?

A. Tomorrow morning, if possible.
B. Let me check... Yes, we have a spot at 10 a.m.

11. That's so kind of you.
12. Thanks for your time.

EXAMPLES:

 - I brought you some coffee.
 - Thank you! I really needed it.

 - I'll take care of the dishes tonight.
 - Thanks! I appreciate the help.

 - I bought a birthday cake for your mom.
 - Thank you very much.
4.
 - I picked up your groceries from the store.
 - Thanks a lot.
5.
 - I fixed the problem with your laptop.
 - I really appreciate it.

 - I watched your dog while you were at work.

A. I really appreciate it! It was a perfect evening.
B. I'm glad! We should do this again soon.

 - You're welcome.

 - No problem. It didn't take long.

A. Perfect! Thank you so much for your help.
B. Glad I could help.

10. I'm sorry if I hurt you.
11. I was wrong.
12. I regret that.

EXAMPLES:

1.
 - You brought me the wrong order.
 - I'm sorry. I'll fix it right away.
2.
 - You sent me the wrong invoice.
 - My apologies. I'll resend the correct one right away.
3.
 - You took my parking spot.
 - I didn't mean to. I didn't know it was yours.
4.
 - Your phone was ringing during the meeting.
 - I apologize. I forgot to silence it.
5.
 - You called me by the wrong name!
 - Sorry about that. I got confused.
6.
 - You scratched my car.
 - That was my fault. I'll pay for the repair.
7.
 - You forgot our anniversary again.
 - Please forgive me. I'll make it up to you.
8.
 - You ate the last slice of pizza without asking!
 - I shouldn't have done that.
9.
 - You didn't take out the trash, and now it smells bad.
 - I messed up. I'll take it out right now.
10.
 - What you said offended me.
 - I'm sorry if I hurt you. I didn't mean to.
11.
 - You said I broke the vase, but it wasn't me.
 - I was wrong. It won't happen again.
12.
 - You didn't visit us during the holidays.
 - I regret that. I really missed you.

CONVERSATION:

- A. You took my umbrella from the office yesterday!
B. Oh no, I didn't mean to. I thought it was mine.
A. It's okay, but I really needed it. I got soaked in the rain.
B. Sorry about that. I feel terrible. I'll bring it back tomorrow.
- A. And this morning, you spilled coffee on my report!
B. That was my fault. I wasn't paying attention.
A. Please be more careful next time.
B. I will. I'm really sorry about all this.

 - I'm afraid not. I didn't see them there.

 - Are you a big fan of action movies?
 - Not really. I prefer comedies.
3.
 - Is the library open on Sundays?
 - I don't think so. It's usually closed.
4.
 - Did you know that Sara quit her job?
 - No way! She just got promoted.
5.
 - Can we get a table by the window?
 - Unfortunately, no. All those tables are reserved.
6.
 - Do you want to come to karaoke night?
 - I'd rather not. I'm not a good singer.
7.
 - Do you want to join our membership program?
 - Sorry, but no. I'm not interested.
8.
 - Am I bothering you with all my questions?
 - Not at all. Feel free to ask anything.

 - Should we buy another TV?
 - Absolutely not! We already have three TVs.

 - Can I ask you something? Where is the toolbox?
 - It's in the garage.

 - Sure, no problem.

 - No problem, I'll show you.

 - Can you show me how to do this? I don't know how to set up the TV.

B. Maybe someone found it. Let's check the coffee shop.
A. Good idea. Thank you so much for helping me!
B. No problem. Let's go.

12. That's wonderful news!

EXAMPLES:

 - We're getting married next month!
 - Congratulations! I'm so happy for you two!

 - I passed my math exam!
 - Well done! I knew you could do it.

 - I cleaned the entire kitchen.
 - Great job! It looks so tidy.

 - I just bought a new car!
